Special Olympics Asia Pacific Bocce and Bowling Competition 2024 will be held in New Delhi. The competition is specifically designed for lower ability athletes in senior age group. The event expects participation of 15 countries from three regions of Special Olympics International.

Executive Summary:

Special Olympics aims to provide year-round sports training and athletic competition to children and adults with Intellectual and Developmental Disabilities in various Olympic type sports. Through sports, they experience joy, develop courage and share their abilities with their families and communities at large.

Covid-19 most impacted the participation of our athletes in sports. Nearly 95% of our athletes could not train and participate in sports events thus impacting their fitness and well-being, as sports is a major catalyst in maintaining their health and life-skills. As part of Return to Play campaign, which focuses on bringing the athletes back to sports fields, Special Olympics is creating platforms for our athletes to participate at various levels. This provides them with motivation to keep practising and stay fit.

Adults with intellectual disabilities often face significant barriers to participation in competitive activities. These barriers can lead to social isolation, decreased physical activity, and a lower quality of life as they progress. According to our census studies, 94% of adults with intellectual disabilities above the age of 22 year could not have access to suitable sports training and competitions that accommodate their unique needs.

Special Olympics events of Bocce and Bowling focus on developing eye-hand coordination, cognitive abilities and decision-making abilities of athletes with special needs.





The Games:

Special Olympics International has National programs in 192 countries which are administratively divided in to seven regions: Africa, Asia Pacific, East Asia, Europe/Eurasia, Latin America, North America, Middle East/North Africa.

The above-mentioned competition is first of its kind, where in our athletes in age group 22+ years and of lower ability ¹will be participating at regional level from four different regions. We expect participation from 15 countries including Australia, Bangladesh, Bharat, Hong Kong, Kazakhstan, Philippines, Macau, Malaysia, Myanmar, New Zealand, Singapore, Indonesia, Uzbekistan, Thailand, & Timor Leste. Teams from Africa and America have also expressed their interest to participate. (Three regions)

The competition is traditional in nature where only athletes with Intellectual and Developmental Disabilities will participate. We expect participation of **250 athletes**, coaches and officials from **15** countries.

The competition will be held under the guidance of Special Olympics International, National Sports Federation for Bowling and supported by Sports Authority of India & Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports, Government of India.

¹ Lower ability means the athletes who require more support and adaptation while performing sports - skills. They require more effort and support in developing their sports skills too.





Goals of the Program

Special Olympics Bharat through the event plans to:

- Introduce a new official sports discipline Bowling to our existing events.
- Develop focus on increased participation in sports programs for adults with IDD in lower ability category.
- Conduct Healthy Athletes program to access the health requirements of the athletes with IDD

The primary objective of this program is to create a supportive and encouraging environment where adults with intellectual disabilities can participate in competitive activities. This will be first ever event where we are inviting athletes in category of 22+ years and with lower ability. Specific goals include:

Sports:

- o Train 50 coaches in new discipline of Bowling
- Develop focussed events for 500 lower ability athletes at state-level for Bowling.
- Develop focussed events for 2500 athletes in the age group and category at grassroot level in Bocce.
- o Conduct National Games for 250 athletes each in Bocce and Bowling.
- Organize Special Olympics Asia Pacific Regional Games in Bowling and Bocce 2024, with participation of 15 countries.

Health:

- Train new Clinical Directors in Special Olympics health disciplines for more local resource.
- Screening of 500 children with IDD in seven health parameters of Special Olympics such as Opening Eyes, Special Smiles, Healthy Hearing, Fit Feet, Fun Fitness, Health Promotion, Strong Minds

Secondly, it will help in creating opportunities for our athletes to participate in more international events in future.





Implementation Plan

Our program will be implemented in three phases:

- 1. Development Phase: Collaborate with experts in adaptive recreation to design a range of games.
- 2. Competition Readiness: Conduct a pilot program with a small group of participants to refine the games and approach.
- 3. Regional Games:
 - Sports:
 - Conduct of Regional Games for 15 countries staffed by trained volunteers and supported by professional staff.
 - Health:
 - o Healthy Athletes ²- Organize and Train New Clinical Directors
 - o Performance station ³ for the athletes participating in the event

Development Phase will include training of 25 officials and 50 coaches from 25 states. They will be responsible for conduct of event and train athletes locally.

Competition Readiness will comprise of hosting a National Games for 250 athletes as pilot games for new discipline and pre-training of the Regional Games.

Regional Games will be held in New Delhi from $18^{th} - 23^{rd}$ November 2024 through the trained volunteers and professionals in sports, health and other areas. The event will see participation of 250 athletes & coaches from 15 countries. The event will be supported by 500 volunteers & officials from India and International offices.

The games will include adapted versions of Bocce and Bowling which are physical activities designed to ensure inclusivity and engagement for all ability levels.

Healthy Athletes is Special Olympics Health program, where athletes are screened for their health requirements such as Eyes, Ears, Dental, Physio-therapy, Feet, Nutrition and Psychological support
 Performance Station is the area where athletes learn to cool down after the event as well as they are educated on hydration, nutrition etc.





Budget

In Special Olympics, the host country is required to cater to all local expenses of the team. Given below is the estimated budget for the event:
